

TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH

BY-LAW NUMBER 8-94

A BY-LAW TO REGULATE, GOVERN OR
PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED
SNOW VEHICLES WITHIN THE CORPORATION
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH

WHEREAS Subsection 7 (2) of the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.M. 44 provides for regulating, governing or prohibiting the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Woolwich deems it desirable to pass a by-law with respect to the regulating, governing or prohibiting of motorized snow vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this by-law:
 - a) "motorized snow vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven primarily on snow.
 - b) "settlement area" means a built up area as defined in the Township of Woolwich Official Plan.
2. No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle within any settlement area within the Township of Woolwich during the following hours:
 - a) between the hours of 11 o'clock p.m. of any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday and the hour of 7 o'clock a.m. of the following day (unless the following day is a holiday);
 - b) between the hour of 1 o'clock a.m. and the hour of 7 o'clock a.m. of any Saturday, Sunday or holiday.
3. No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle in or upon the following public municipal lands: public parks, playgrounds, walkways or cemeteries.
4. No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle along a sidewalk situated on any highway.
5. Nothing in this by-law applies to prohibit the operation of a motorized snow vehicle by the following:
 - a) a member of the Waterloo Regional Police Service or the Ontario Provincial Police while engaged in the performance of his/her duty as a Police Officer.

- b) by an employee of the Township of Woolwich, the Regional Municipality of Waterloo or a local board while engaged in authorized duties.
 - c) by any persons engaged in a bona fide rescue or emergency operation under the direction of or with the authority of the Waterloo Regional Police Service or the Ontario Provincial Police or the Township of Woolwich.
6. Every person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable, upon conviction, to a fine or penalty not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), exclusive of costs, for each offence as prescribed in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.P. 33 as amended.
7. By-law Number 11-81 of the Township of Woolwich, and any other by-law inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law are hereby repealed.
8. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its final passing.
9. This by-law may be known as the "Snowmobile Control By-law".
