Elmira, Ontario, September 29, 2010 – We wish to inform the community of our plans to address the release of one of our products (BLE) on Monday, September 27. We have been working with representatives from the Township of Woolwich, Chemtura's Public Advisory Committee (CPAC) and the Ministry of Ontario (MOE) to ensure that the clean up of affected vehicles, homes and other property is done in a manner that is satisfactory to the owner and that is of minimal inconvenience.

In this regard we have taken and will take the following steps:

1. Cleaning of Vehicles:

Arrangements have been made to have vehicles cleaned at the businesses identified below, with all costs for the cleaning being billed directly to Chemtura. In order to facilitate this process we ask that you call the hotline number below to leave your name, address, phone number and licence plate number of the vehicle(s) that require cleaning. You will then be able to contact either company to arrange the cleaning. Should you wish to use any other service please contact the hotline number to obtain information on how reimbursement will be managed.
