

TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH

BY-LAW NUMBER 115-99

**A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES PASSING OVER CERTAIN BRIDGES  
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH (Triple Posting)**

WHEREAS Subsection 123(2) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.H. 8, as amended, provides that "the Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a bridge may, by by-law, limit the gross vehicle weight of any vehicle or any class thereof passing over such a bridge, and the requirements of subsection (1) with respect to the posting up of notice apply thereto";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to limit the weight of vehicles passing over bridges in the Township of Woolwich based on a report prepared by W.E. Kelley and Associates Limited, dated November 8, 1999.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No vehicle or combination of vehicles or any class thereof whether empty or loaded, shall be operated over the bridge situate on the Road Allowance at Lot 19, German Company Tract; Township road 43; Structure No. 370143 (Former #0024); M.T.O. Site No. 033-0082; where the gross weight of such vehicle or combination of vehicles or any class thereof exceeds

19 Tonnes	for a Single Vehicle
30 Tonnes	for a Combination of Two Vehicles
40 Tonnes	for a Combination of Three Vehicles
2. Any person violating the provisions of this By-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 125 of the Highway Traffic Act.
3. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of passage and when a notice of the limit of weight permitted, legibly printed, has been posted in a conspicuous place at each end of the bridge.
4. By-law Number 79-95 is hereby repealed.
