BY-LAW NUMBER 52-2008

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 1-1993 BEING
A BY-LAW TO MAINTAIN, MANAGE AND REGULATE CEMETERIES IN THE TOWNSHIP
OF WOOLWICH**

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 50, Cemeteries Act (Revised) R.S.O. 1990 Chapter 4, that By-laws may be passed by councils of local municipalities for the maintenance, management, regulation and control of any cemetery owned by the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Woolwich has passed By-law 1-1993 being a by-law passed by the Township of Woolwich to maintain, manage and regulate cemeteries.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH AMENDS SECTION 4.10 OF BY-LAW #1-1993 TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

4.10 In one standard size (adult) grave, the number of regular interments shall be restricted to a maximum of two (2), the first of which must be at extra depth, and up to a maximum of four (4) cremation interments, providing that all regular interments take place prior to any cremation interments.
