



CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE OF PERMIT

CURB & GUTTER:

1. Where curb cuts are required, the Applicant shall be responsible for the curb cut. All curb cut lengths shall be as noted and shall conform to the latest issue of Ontario Provincial Standard Drawing No. 600.01 (copy attached). There are two methods of constructing curb cuts which are acceptable to the Township:
 - a) The curb section may be cut to the dimensions specified in O.P.S.D. 600.01, and shall be done by a Contractor experienced in the construction of saw cut curb drops.
 - b) A complete section of Curb and Gutter may be removed and replaced with a poured concrete Curb and Gutter, with the required drop section. The Curb and Gutter Section at each end shall be saw cut and asphalt impregnated fibrous expansion joints shall be installed at the section between the proposed Curb and Gutter and the existing Curb and Gutter. Concrete shall conform to:
 - Class 30 Mpa at 28d;
 - 19 mm max. nominal size coarse aggregate;
 - Maximum slump 60 mm;
 - Air Content $7.0 \pm 1.5\%$;

OPSD standards available on request for curb profiles other than concrete barrier curb with wide gutter (No. 600.01).

Any damage to the road surface shall be rectified to the satisfaction of the Township. Each curb cut, regardless of the method of construction, shall be inspected by a Township representative, and any deficiencies shall be corrected by the applicant prior to final acceptance and refund of the Damage Deposit.

CULVERTS:

1. The Applicant shall supply all culvert materials, as required by the Township.
2. The installation of an entrance culvert up to 1 metre in diameter shall be undertaken by the owner or his contractor in strict conformity with the attached Township of Woolwich instructions.
3. The installation of an entrance culvert greater than 1 metre diameter shall be undertaken by a Contractor approved by the Township, and shall conform to the latest issue of Ontario Provincial Standards Drawing No. 802.01 or other OPSD as required. (copies available).
